Will I save on energy costs by replacing my water heater with a tankless model?


The cost-saving benefit of replacing a conventional electric water heater with a tankless model is often overestimated. Tankless models don't have a water storage tank; therefore, water has to be heated much more quickly as it passes through a compact heating unit. This typically requires an upgraded electrical circuit to handle the extra power.

Now there is an attractive alternative called a heat pump water heater (HPWH), which requires no electrical upgrades and can save up to 60 percent on water heating costs.
