

This charge, which helps pay for previous hurricane restoration costs, is adjusted periodically during the year following Florida Public Service Commission review and approval. The storm charge, effective Sept. 2, will be \$1.56 per 1,500 kWh for small, non-demand business customers. View information about your specific rate class:
