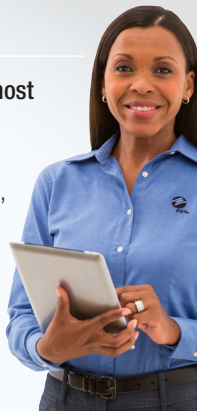

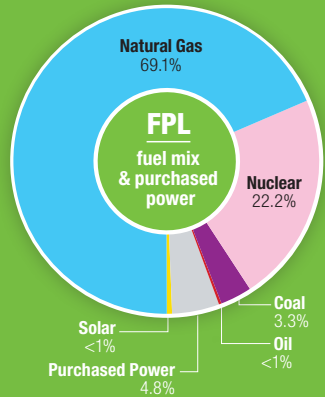

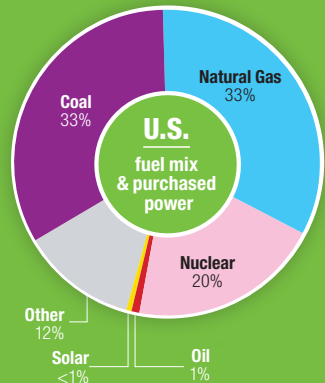
## What powers Florida homes?
