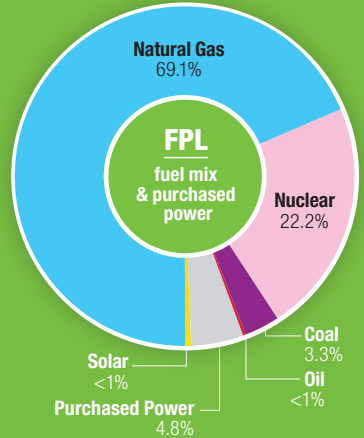

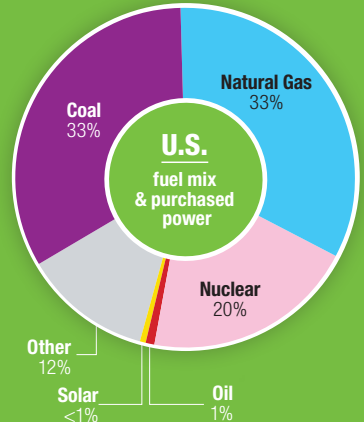
What powers Florida businesses?
